1,000 Year Period

Rev. 20

No events to create a timeline, just facts and information.

More detail about current events is given after the 1,000 yrs than now.

Thoughts about this 1,000 year time:

Reproduction, growth in population.

Rev. 20:8 refers to "Gog and Magog being as the sand of the sea," so how could so many be here after the Tribulation if they didn't grow during the 1,000 yr. period?

Mark 12:23–25 refers to what happens in the resurrection. Jesus said when they shall rise from the dead, they neither marry, nor are given in marriage; but are as the angels which are in heaven.

But this 1,000 yr. period is not heaven, and Gog and Magog weren't raised from the dead, so reproduction could still be happening during this time.

Possible groups of people still here could be:

Rev. 12:6, 20:9

The Jew's that were hidden and protected in the wilderness, which will be called the saints later, and the people who hid them, and

Rev. 20:7–8 The nations that make up Gog and Magog.

First Resurrection Rev. 20:4–6

Those that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, lived and reigned with Christ 1,000 yrs. The other dead will not be resurrected until 1,000 years is finished. showing they lived here during the Tribulation Period.

Rev. 20:1–4

At death, your spirit leaves your body, it does not stay on earth.

The Beheaded were raised to reign and live with Christ.

They are now called "priests", not saints, as referred to those encompassed later by Gog and Magog.

Note that they received their heads along with their new body.

Possible reason they were raised early was being honored for their ultimate sacrifice in standing for God's word. Rev. 20:4

The other dead were not raised until the 1,000 years were over.

No scriptural reference that any came back to earth to reign and live.

Later in scripture, activity is in the area of the Beloved City, Jerusalem. There is not any reference to other parts of the world.

Rev. 20:1–4 Satan bound during this 1,000 year period, cast into the bottomless pit, shut him up, set a seal upon him. Can't be deceiving the nations.

Those who were beheaded, and those who were caught up before the Tribulation come back to reign 1,000 years.
